## Context

## Feedback

Using at least one of the following methods: (1) a town hall meeting, (2) a written survey, or (3) one-on-one interviews, to solicit feedback on the proposed policy.

Then, in 1 or 2 paragraphs, document the main discoveries of your community input.

## Policy

Policy goals are mission-driven, measurable changes in the life of the congregation accomplished by definite date. In 1 paragraph, explain the goals of the policy and how the policy advances the mission of GNUUC.

## Tasks

A policy creates a measurable change in the life of the congregation. The way to create a measurable change is to be specific about what needs to happen, when it will happen, and how it will be monitored. Itemize and explain the actions required by the policy.

## Accountability

For each action define: (1) the timeframe for those actions to occur, (2) the committee or role responsible for taking those actions, and (3) the committee or role responsible for ensuring those actions occur on schedule.
